

PROJECT: 'TOLL OSBORNE' WRECK REMOVAL FROM CONZINC ISLAND 2020

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Oceanic Offshore were contracted by Toll Energy to assist with the Wreck Recovery of the 'TOLL OSBORNE' in 2020 after it was washed up onto the rocks post TC Damien on Conzinc Island off the coast of Dampier.

THE CHALLENGE

This included several scopes of work including the following:

- Fuel and ballast transfer
- Depollution of items containing hazardous substances incl batteries
- · Security checks to establish vessels continuing condition
- Beach Cleanup of Conzinc Island
- Preparation of the vessel for refloat
- Facilitate the refloat of the vessel
- Tow the vessel to the designated mooring
- Inspect and report on the vessels condition
- Facilitate the docking of the vessel at TDSB Slipway for decommissioning

KEY OUTCOMES
